TO OPERATE THE SPYX DOOR ALARM- Motion Detector

1. Attach the Door Alarm over the door knob of your door.
2. Turn the Alarm to the ON position (Fig. 1). The red LED will flash and after 3 seconds the Alarm is set and ready to go!
3. You can test the Alarm by twisting the door knob or by moving the Alarm back & forth a few times. The Alarm will sound through the speaker. After the Alarm sounds it will reset automatically.
4. Turn the Door Alarm off when not using it to make the batteries last longer

USING THE FLEXIBLE CABLE

When not in use, the flexible cable can wrap around the Alarm in storage mode (Fig. 3) or you can detach one end of the cable to wrap around door knobs, backpack loops or anything you want to protect. Slide the end of the flexible cable back into any one of the open slots on the Alarm body and then switch the Door Alarm to the ON position to set it.

Note that you can use the SpyX Door Alarm on any movable surface and if it detects motion the alarm will sound.

- NOTE: Screws will not detach from battery compartment cover.**
3. Place batteries in the compartment as shown.
4. Replace battery compartment cover and tighten screws.

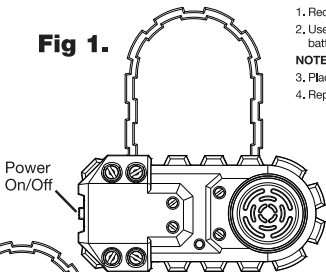
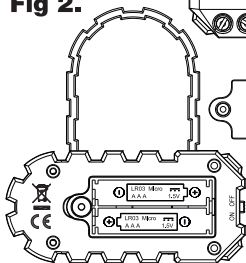
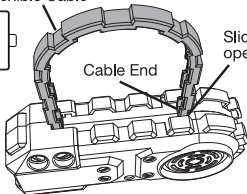

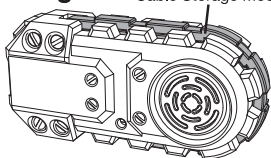
Flexible Cable

How to play with your SpyX Night Nocs

TO USE THE SpyX Night 'Nocs as Daytime Binoculars

1. Look through the **EYEPIECES** and rotate the **FOCUS WHEEL** until the image becomes sharp.

To use the SpyX Night 'Nocs at night (Fig 1.)

1. Slide the switch that is on the left to turn on the Night Vision light
2. If you want to go super stealth, slide the switch on the right side which will engage the Red "Stealth" filter so you can avoid detection while still spying at night. You can switch it back to White LED light at any time by moving the switch back to its original position.

2. Remove all old batteries.
3. Place new batteries in compartment as shown
4. Replace the battery cover and tighten screw.

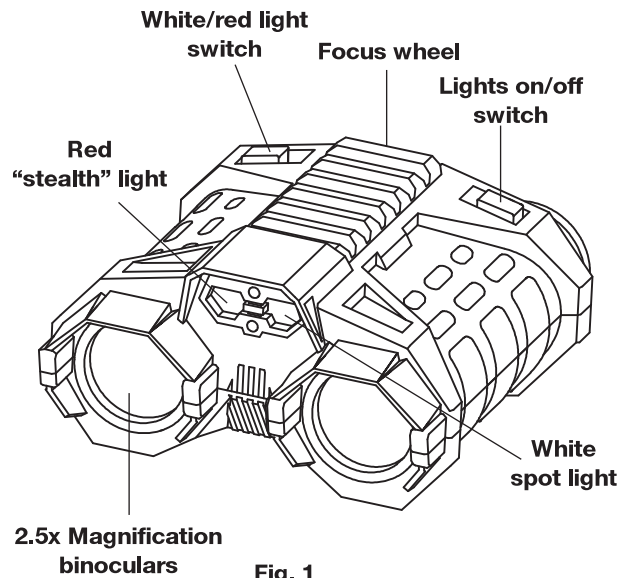

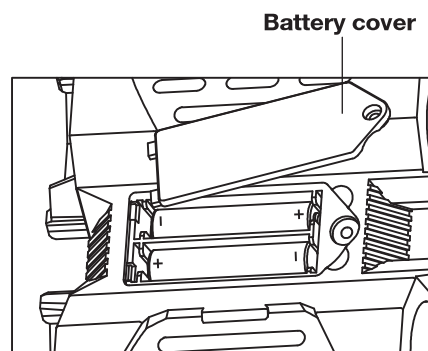

TO SET NORMAL TIME, DATE, ALARM, & 24-HOUR DISPLAY

1. (Figure 1) Press the <A> MODE button three (3) times to enter setup mode. The Seconds mode will flash.
2. Press the <C> START button to reset Seconds to zero (0)
3. Then Press RESET button to cycle through each of the settings (Seconds, Hours, Minutes, Month, Day, Week, 12/24 hour Display)
4. For each setting, when it flashes, Press the <C> START button to increase the value.
5. When finished setting the Normal time Press MODE <A> to save and exit the Time setting mode.

TO USE THE STOPWATCH

1. When in the Normal Time Mode, Press <A> MODE button one (1) time. The ST Symbol will appear in top corner.
2. Press <C> START to start/ stop the timer.
3. When time is stopped, press RESET to reset time to zero.
4. When time is still running, press RESET to get SPLIT time.
5. Press <C> START to stop the timer then Press RESET to view SPLIT Time and TOTAL time

TO SET DAILY ALARM

1. When in the Normal Time Mode, Press <A> MODE button twice (2 times). The AL Symbol will appear in top corner.
2. Press RESET button to cycle through each setting (Hours & Minutes)
3. For each setting, when it flashes, Press the <C> START button to increase the value.
4. When finished setting the Daily Alarm Press MODE <A> to save and exit the setting mode.

TO USE THE DAILY ALARM

1. You can check to see if the Daily Alarm is set by looking for the  symbol on the top right corner of the Normal Time Display.
2. When Daily Alarm Sounds press any button to silence the Alarm
3. To activate/deactivate the Daily Alarm, Press <A> MODE button twice (2 times). The AL Symbol will appear in top corner. Then Press the <C> START button to toggle Alarm on or off. (the  symbol indicates it is on)

TO USE THE LED LIGHT

1. Press the LIGHT BUTTON (D) to activate the night vision spotlight

TO USE SAFE-DROP MESSAGE CAPSULES

1. Hide tiny messages inside the capsule, then hide them for you or your friends to find later!

TO USE THE SPY TELESCOPE

1. Flip up the SpyX Watch Face to reveal the Spy Telescope! (Figure 2)
2. With your finger press down on the ridge of the Telescope Lens to tilt up the lens. (do it for both lenses)
3. Lens B remains in place while Lens A can slide in and out. (Figure 3)
4. To magnify objects far-away. Look at the object through both Lens A and Lens B (HINT: Slide Lens A in and out to adjust the focus)
5. For close-up Magnification use only Lens B close to the Object you want to magnify
6. When you are done using the Telescope make sure to slide Lens A all the way back in and push both lenses back into the recessed space.

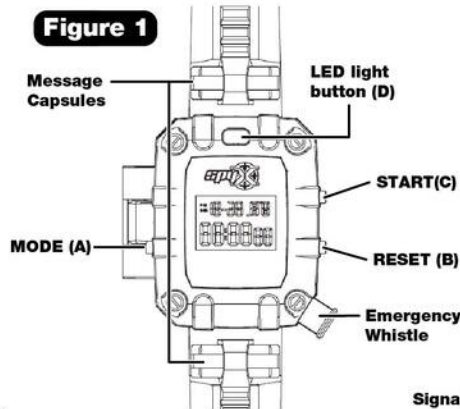

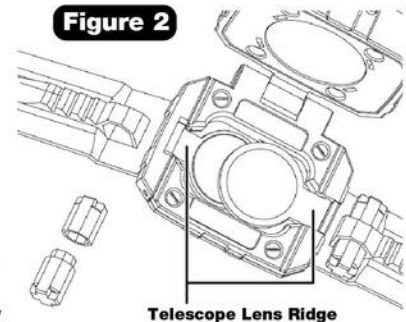
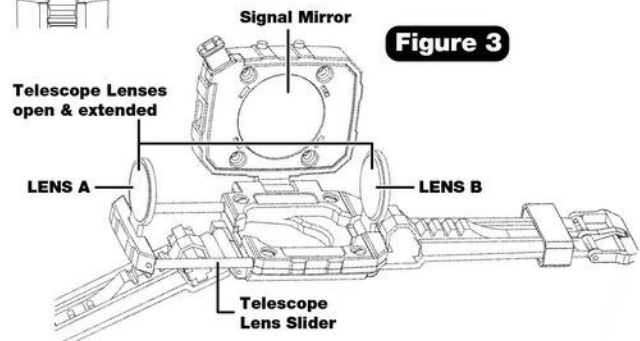

ATTENTION ADULTS-TO REPLACE BATTERIES

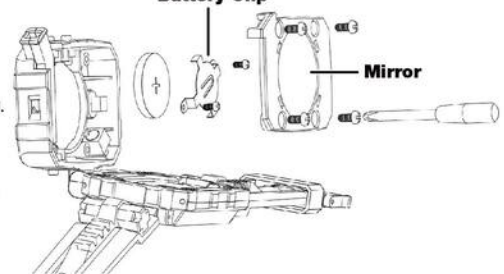
The SpyX 6-in-1 Watch requires 1 (CR2016) 3V lithium button-cell, included.

1. Tilt up the watch face to reveal the Signal Mirror. (Figure 4) Loosen the 4 Philips-head screws on the Mirror Cover and remove.
2. Loosen the 2 SCREWS on the BATTERY CLIP Cover. Remove the battery and the clip together. REMEMBER which screws go in each cover
3. Unclip old battery. Install new battery with the + (positive) side up
4. Replace and screw the battery and clip assembly back into position.
5. Replace the Mirror Cover with the 4 screws. Be careful not to tighten it too much or you may damage it.
